Swimming Rules & Regulations

Please comply with the following rules for your maximum enjoyment at the Abbey Lane swimming pool. Abbey Lane pool is a family friendly 'G' rated pool. If any issues arise, please email the Abbey Lane board at: alane.hoa@gmail.com. In an emergency, you may contact: Stormi 417-877-7554. The pool is being overseen by volunteers from the pool committee and board. Each member at Abbey Lane is expected to know and follow the rules.

<u>The pool is open daily Memorial Weekend – Labor Day</u> <u>Pool Hours: 9:00 am – 10:00 am Adult Swim</u> 10:00am – 9:00 General Swim

- 1. All members must enter and leave the pool area with their fob. Under no circumstances are you to open the pool gates to anyone other than those that are in your party. Volunteers may come around to verify members of the community.
- 2. Children under 14 must be accompanied by an adult 18 years and older. Parents are responsible for their children no matter what pool area they are in. Under no circumstances should a parent leave a child unattended, especially in the splash pad area.
- 3. Please accompany children to the bathroom to help maintain cleanliness and order in the bathrooms. *Non toilet-trained children must wear*CLOTH diapers and rubber pants or specified swim diapers in the pool area. If there are accidents in our pool, the pool will need to be closed for 24 hours.
- 4. Guests of all ages must be accompanied by an Abbey Lane member. The member's family may bring no more than 6 guests to the pool at a time. You will be limited to 20 guests per year. Children under 18 in the same household will be allowed 2guests in pool area collectively. That means that if you have two children or more ages 14-18, there is a limit of two total guests between all of them.
- 5. Swim wear must be the attire used when in the pool. No street clothing is allowed in the pool. Swim wear must be appropriate NO thongs.
- 6. Glass containers of any type are not permitted in any area of the pool.
- 7. No food or beverages are allowed in the pools.
- 8. Smoking, vaping, and alcoholic beverages are not permitted on property,

- 9. Running, scuffling, snapping of towels, horseplay, or tag games around swimming pool decks or immediate areas are prohibited.
- 10. Only pool regulated balls are allowed. (Footballs are not allowed).
- 11. Profanity, improper behavior (which includes improper displays of affection), and vulgar remarks are prohibited. Anyone who exhibits these behaviors may be asked by the manager or another Abbey Lane member to leave the premises.
- 12. Any injuries, accidents or problems should be reported to the Abbey Lane board so it can be dealt with accordingly.
- 13. Persons with open cuts or other infections must not enter the swimming pool areas.
- 14. Trash should be placed in the containers located by the pool gate.
- 15. Do not dive in the pool. Do not play with or sit on the rope. Do no play with the life saving devices alongside the pool.
- 16. No animals are allowed within the pool area or along entrance of pool.
- 17. The swimming pool will be closed at the discretion of the pool manger in cases of inclement weather and /or emergency situations. During electrical storms no one shall remain in the pool area.
- 18. Any feces or vomit in the pool necessitates the pool to be closed for a minimum of 24 hours or until the pool chemicals are balanced.
- 19. Make sure to dry off before entering the bathroom area.
- 20. Members are to clean up after themselves and return any moved furniture.
- 21. Do no be in the area where pool equipment is located.

**Please remember that we are all a part of this great community and we all need to do our part to maintain the Abbey Lane pool. Volunteers are overseeing the day-to-day operations, but the bulk of the responsibility will be on the members to ensure the success of our pool season. Violation of rules may result in being asked to leave, being contacted by the board via phone or letter, and/or fob being turned off.
